HON L ENOCH ASKED MINISTER FOR POLICE AND EMERGENCY SERVICES (HON D PURDIE)—

QUESTION:

Will the Minister advise for the 2024 and 2025 calendar years (reported separately by month and correlating year) the total number of (a) sworn police officer overtime hours worked across the state and (b) rostered police officer hours worked across the state?

ANSWER:

I am advised by the Queensland Police Service (QPS) that:

- a) The below table contains the claimed overtime hours worked by month & calendar year for police officers for 2024 and 2025. This includes critical incident, special and regular overtime hours.
