MS J PUGH ASKED THE MINISTER FOR EDUCATION AND THE ARTS (HON J LANGBROEK)—

QUESTION:

Will the Minister advise the total amount allocated in the 2026–27 Queensland Budget for Middle Park State School toilet/amenities upgrades?

ANSWER:

I am advised:

In 2026–27, Middle Park State School (SS) has been allocated \$94,412 in maintenance and minor works funding, which can be used for amenities upgrades, with decisions in relation to the allocation and use of funding at the discretion of the Principal.

Additionally, the Crisafulli Government is delivering a new \$11 million General Learning Centre, which includes student and staff amenities.

Statewide Asset Lifecycle Condition Assessments (ALCA) for education assets were completed between January 2022 and December 2023. These assessments inform planning for maintenance and renewal works.

More broadly, the Department of Education's *Comprehensive Review of Infrastructure Renewal* report released in August 2025, highlighted a renewal backlog of \$441 million has accumulated due to the level of renewal funding in prior years being insufficient to address renewal needs.

In June 2022, amenities at Middle Park SS were inspected as part of the ALCA program. The assessment found that of the five amenities blocks, three were rated as poor and two were rated as fair. An additional five buildings containing amenities were also assessed, with four rated as poor and one rated as fair.
