HON L LINARD asked the Deputy Premier, Minister for State Development, Infrastructure and Planning and Minister for Industrial Relations (HON J BLEIJIE) –

QUESTION:

With reference to the Banyo Provisional Priority Development Area, located at 56 Blinzinger Road, Banyo—

Will the Deputy Premier advise if any development applications submitted to Economic Development Queensland as assessment manager will be publicly released once lodged, and prior to approval, for public viewing and consultation?

ANSWER:

The Crisafulli Government is giving more Queenslanders a place to call home following a decade of decline under the former Labor Government where a 36 per cent reduction in new home approvals led to a skyrocketing social housing waitlist.

Priority Development Area development applications lodged with Economic Development Queensland (EDQ) as assessment manager are published on the EDQ website and have been since 2013.

The Land Use Plan was publicly notified from 1 to 19 June 2026, giving the community another opportunity to comment on the development vision for the Banyo precinct.
