MR L RICHMOND ASKED THE MINISTER FOR YOUTH JUSTICE AND VICTIM SUPPORT AND MINISTER FOR CORRECTIVE SERVICES (HON L GERBER)

QUESTION:

With reference to the announcement of the new 'Queensland Protection Commission'-

Will the Minister advise (a) which divisions or services whose functions currently sit within the Department of Youth Justice and Victim Support will be transferred to the new Commission and (b) on what date these divisions or services will officially commence their functions under the new Commission?

ANSWER:

Although the Queensland Government has announced its intention to establish the Queensland Protection Commission, the enabling Bill to establish the Commission has not yet been introduced into Parliament. As a result, key details about the Commission's functions, structure and operations are not yet available.

Subject to the passage of legislation, the proposed commencement of the Queensland Protection Commission is February 2027. Until the Bill is introduced and considered by Parliament, the information requested is not known at this stage.
