MR P RUSSO ASKED ATTORNEY-GENERAL AND MINISTER FOR JUSTICE AND MINISTER FOR INTEGRITY (HON D FRECKLINGTON) -

QUESTION:

Will the Attorney-General advise the number of staff within the Department of Justice on temporary contracts (reported separately by both headcount and FTE) as at 1 January 2025, 1 July 2025, 1 January 2026 and 25 June 2026 (or closest reportable dates)?

ANSWER:

Agency annual reports to the Parliament include the percentage of their total workforce who are employed on a permanent, temporary, contract and casual basis.

I am advised that this level of disclosure is the same as that which applied in the last year of the former government.

This government does not propose to divert any public sector resources from delivering for Queensland to alter this disclosure format.

The information for the last full fortnight of the June 2026 quarter will be available in the 2025-2026 annual report of the Department of Justice which will be tabled later this year in line with legislative requirements.
