HON C DICK asked the Deputy Premier, Minister for State Development, Infrastructure and Planning and Minister for Industrial Relations (HON J BLEIJIE) –

QUESTION:

Will the Deputy Premier advise the number of staff within the Department of State Development, Infrastructure and Planning on temporary contracts (reported separately by both headcount and FTE) as at 1 January 2025, 1 July 2025, 1 January 2026 and 25 June 2026 (or closest reportable dates)?

ANSWER:

I am advised that there were 151.13 full-time equivalents employed on a temporary basis in the Department of State Development, Infrastructure and Planning in the last full fortnight of the June 2025 quarter.

I am advised that this level of disclosure is the same as that which applied in the last year of the former government.

This government does not propose to divert any public sector resources from delivering for Queensland to alter this disclosure format.

The information for the last full fortnight of the June 2026 quarter will be available in the 2025-2026 annual report of the Department of State Development, Infrastructure and Planning, which will be tabled later this year in line with legislative requirements.
