HON L ENOCH ASKED THE MINISTER FOR HOUSING AND PUBLIC WORKS AND MINISTER FOR YOUTH (**HON S O'CONNOR**)—

QUESTION:

With reference to Page 13 of Budget Paper 4 of the 2026-27 Queensland Budget – for the line item ‘Effective and Efficient Regulation for the Housing System’—

Will the Minister provide a breakdown of how funding will be dispersed between (a) community housing providers, (b) disability accommodation, (c) retirement villages and (d) residential services?

ANSWER:

Budget Paper 4 of the 2026-27 Queensland Budget, line item ‘Effective and Efficient Regulation for the Housing System’ identifies funding for the Department of Housing and Public Works (the department) for its role in governing a fair and sustainable regulated accommodation sector for Queenslanders residing in residential services, manufactured homes (residential parks), retirement villages, community housing and disability accommodation.

The department operates a functional model that covers intake and registration, compliance, investigations, stakeholder engagement and regulatory service delivery across these housing and accommodation sectors. The model allocates resources flexibly and strategically in response to regulatory priorities, emerging risks, service demand and legislative obligations rather than being assigned to specific industries or accommodation types. Given the dynamic nature of this model, it is not feasible to provide a fixed funding breakdown by industry.

This model ensures the department can effectively address emerging risks, optimise resources, and deliver quality regulatory outcomes for Queenslanders.
