- 907 **MS J BUSH** ASKED MINISTER FOR HEALTH AND AMBULANCE SERVICES (HON T NICHOLLS)
- With reference to the Chief Psychiatrist Policy under the Mental Health Act 2016 – where it states the Chief Psychiatrist is required to report critical incidents, including the death of someone who received treatment or care as a patient of the Authorised Mental Health Service (AMHS) during the preceding 30 days, however, this is only 'if the AMHS becomes aware' of the death—
- Will the Minister provide details of the mechanisms in place to ensure AMHS' are being informed of a patient's suicide within 30 days of release from an AMHS?
