MS M MCMAHON ASKED THE ATTORNEY-GENERAL AND MINISTER FOR JUSTICE AND MINISTER FOR INTEGRITY (HON D FRECKLINGTON)

QUESTION:

With reference to the government allocating \$10m in the 2025-26 Budget to acquire land for a new Beenleigh Courthouse—

Will the Attorney-General advise (a) what consultation has occurred in identifying a new location and (b) what the timeline for procurement of the site is?

ANSWER:

I thank the Member for Macalister for her question.

I am advised after years of under investment by Labor, the Department of Justice has undertaken preliminary consultation relating to potential locations for a new Beenleigh Courthouse with key stakeholders, including the Member as the local State Member, Queensland Police Service, council infrastructure planning staff, legal and service provider stakeholders, and the judiciary.

The Department of Justice will undertake further consultation with the community, key stakeholders, and surrounding landowners as part of the assessment process once potentially suitable site options are identified.
