HIS Excellency the Governor, acting by and with the advice of the Executive Council and in pursuance of the provisions of "The Hospitals Acts, 1936 to 1967," has been pleased to make the following Regulation.

The Regulations dated 24th May, 1945, published in the *Government Gazette* of 24th May, 1945, as subsequently amended from time to time, relating to Part II—Hospitals Board Service Administration are hereby amended as follows:—

Regulation 2 is amended by addition thereto of the following new paragraph:—

"For the purpose of paragraph (b) of the proviso to this Regulation and Regulation 5 of this Part of the Regulations made in pursuance of the provisions of "The Hospitals Acts, 1936 to 1967," where an employee in the service of the North Brisbane Hospitals Board, The South Brisbane Hospitals Board or some other Board constituted for a District within the area comprised by the City of Brisbane and the City of Redcliffe is an applicant for a vacancy in a position in the employment of another of those Boards, then such employee shall be deemed to be employed by such lastmentioned Board."

The Deputy Governor, for and on behalf of His Excellency the Governor, acting by and with the advice of the Executive Council and in pursuance of the provisions of "*The Hospitals Acts, 1936 to 1967*," has been pleased to make the following Regulation.

The Regulations cited as "The Hospitals Officers and Employees' Long Service Leave Regulations" dated 10th June, 1965, published in the *Government Gazette* of 12th June, 1965, are hereby amended as follows:—

Regulation 5 (iv) is revoked and the following Regulation 5 (iv) is inserted in lieu thereof:—

"(iv) The permanent head of the Department of Health shall either—

- (a) Approve the application of the officer or employee; or
- (b) Approve the application altered with the concurrence of the officer or employee in respect of the period of leave to be granted and/or the time of commencement of such leave; or
- (c) If he is not satisfied that the conditions contained in paragraphs (a) and (b) of sub-clause (iii) hereof are or will be complied with, refuse or defer consideration of the application.

The permanent head of the Department of Health shall notify the officer or employee and the Secretary of the Hospitals Board concerned in writing of his decision upon the application and where the application is approved, the officer or employee shall, subject as hereinafter provided, be granted long service leave in accordance with such approval."
