1 Introduction

1.1 Role of the Committee

The Education and Innovation Committee (the Committee) is a portfolio committee established by the <u>Parliament of Queensland Act 2001</u> and the Standing Orders of the Legislative Assembly on 18 May 2012. It consists of government and non-government members. The Committee's primary areas of responsibility are education, training, employment, science, information technology, innovation and the arts.

Section 93(1) of the *Parliament of Queensland Act 2001* provides that a portfolio committee is responsible for examining each Bill and item of subordinate legislation in its portfolio area to consider:

- a) the policy to be given effect by the legislation,
- b) the application of fundamental legislative principles to the legislation, and
- c) for subordinate legislation its lawfulness.

1.2 Aim of this report

This report advises of subordinate legislation examined and, where applicable, presents any concerns the Committee has identified in respect of subordinate legislation tabled between 21 June 2012 and 11 July 2012 that are within its portfolio responsibilities.
