EDUCATION AND OTHER LEGISLATION AMENDMENT BILL 2016

QUEENSLAND GOVERNMENT RESPONSE

INTRODUCTION

On 24 May 2016, the Education and Other Legislation Amendment Bill 2016 (the Bill) was introduced into Parliament.

The Bill was referred to the Education, Tourism, Innovation and Small Business Committee (the Committee), with a report back of 2 August 2016.

On 2 August 2016, the Committee tabled its report (No. 14) in relation to the Bill.

The Queensland Government response to the recommendations made by the Committee is provided below.

RESPONSE TO RECOMMENDATIONS

Recommendation 1

The Committee recommends that the Education and Other Legislation Amendment Bill 2016 be passed.

Government response

The Government thanks the Committee for its consideration of the Bill and notes the Committee's recommendation that the Bill be passed.

Recommendation 2

The Committee recommends that minor amendments be made to correct a cross reference in clause 115 and the application, in clause 133, of proposed section 288(6)(a).

Government response

The Government supports this recommendation and will make these minor technical amendments.
