# Shopping with your Cashless Debit Card

The Cashless Debit Card looks and operates like a regular debit card and can be used at almost any merchant that accepts Visa or eftpos. The Cashless Debit Card is also accepted online at merchants that do not sell restricted goods and services. The Cashless Debit Card program has arrangements in place to manage merchants that sell restricted goods, or a mixture of restricted and unrestricted goods.

A Mixed Merchant is a business that sells both restricted and unrestricted goods. Common examples of restricted goods are alcohol, gambling products, and specific gift and prepaid cards. Most Mixed Merchants will be able to accept your Cashless Debit Card for some purchases. Participating Mixed Merchants, included in the list below, have signed an agreement to accept the Cashless Debit Card.

Most Participating Mixed Merchants are pubs or hotels and have a dedicated terminal that does not sell restricted goods, where you can use your Cashless Debit Card to purchase food or accommodation. Businesses who primarily sell unrestricted goods, such as licensed cafés and restaurants, will be able to accept the Cashless Debit Card automatically and will not appear on the Participating Mixed Merchant List.

Some merchants are blocked from accepting the Cashless Debit Card. Businesses whose primary business is selling restricted goods (such as pubs, TABs, casinos and bottle shops) will automatically be blocked and will not appear in the Blocked Merchant list below. Some other businesses have been manually blocked to prevent access to cash and the purchasing of restricted goods. Businesses that have been manually blocked are listed in the Blocked Merchant List below.

Please note: Although BPAY payments to Australia Post are blocked, you can pay bills for other merchants (e.g. utility bills) at Australia Post.


