Authorising law

Section 2(2) of the *Local Government Electoral Act 2011*

Policy objectives and the reasons for them

The objective of the proclamation is to commence the following provisions (the provisions) of the *Local Government Electoral Act 2011* relating to swimming pool barriers on common boundaries:

- Part 12, divisions 2, 3 and 14, and
- Part 12, division 12 (to commence immediately after the commencement of the *Neighbourhood Disputes Resolution Act 2011*, section 9).

Achievement of policy objectives

The policy objectives are achieved by the commencement of the provisions on 1 November 2011.

Consistency with policy objectives of authorising law

The Proclamation is consistent with the main objects of the provisions.

Inconsistency with policy objectives of other legislation

Not applicable.

Benefits and costs of implementation

Consistency with fundamental legislative principles

The Proclamation does not conflict with fundamental legislative principles.
