# Transport Planning on the Sunshine Coast Caloundra South CAMCOS Realignment Study

## About the Caloundra South Realignment Study

The Sunshine Coast is one of Queensland's most popular destinations attracting people from Australia and across the globe.

As the Sunshine Coast grows in popularity and size, so too does the demand for public transport and infrastructure. To meet this growing demand, the Queensland Government is committed to building a new rail line that will service the Sunshine Coast and provide a link to Brisbane.

The Queensland Government has already identified and earmarked a route for a passenger train service from Beerwah to Maroochydore, reaching Caloundra in 2015 and Maroochydore by 2020.

The Caloundra City Council has identified a possible alternative route in the Caloundra South and aerodrome section that may have less environmental impact and more public benefit. The realignment study is now looking at this alternative route for the section between the Bruce Highway and Sugar Bag Road.
