Dear Mr Clerk,

I refer to the order of the Legislative Assembly dated 21 August 2024 for a shadow minister or shadow assistant ministers of the 57<sup>th</sup> Parliament to retrospectively declare a list of any meetings they attended in their shadow portfolio capacity which they are aware of, at which a registered lobbyist was in attendance dating back four years to 2020.

I am writing on behalf of shadow ministers and shadow assistant ministers who served in their respective capacities during the 57<sup>th</sup> Parliament.

The Opposition believes this Order contains significant shortcomings which will do little to enhance the integrity of public administration in the state.

These shortcomings were highlighted by Jarrod Bleijie MP, Deputy Leader of the Opposition, at the time of the debate:

*“...this is a government that is so desperate they would pull a stunt like this 41 days from the dissolution of parliament. We have seen parliamentary processes wrecked this week. We have seen democracy continually attacked by this Labor government in their dying days. It is a rotting fish and it is rotting from the head. They are throwing all parliamentary processes out the window. They are rushing through legislation without any committee process. They do not care because they are addicted to power. They will do and say anything in their desperate attempt to cling to that power. I say to honourable colleagues what would you expect from Premier Miles, who is looking more uncomfortable in the job after having served as minister for 10 years in this place. He is looking more and more uncomfortable day by day.*

*... The irony is that the Labor Party were so against retrospectivity as to not release the Jackie Trad report. Yesterday they hated retrospectivity: ‘No. It’s terrible. It’s bad for democracy.’ They did not want anyone to see the Jackie Trad report or the Peter Carne report—that is bad retrospectivity—but they want to see the diaries of opposition shadow ministers from 3½ years ago.*

*What they want to do is tie up the opposition for the next 41 days until the dissolution of parliament so they can campaign, and we cannot. That is what they are trying to do. Everyone can see through it.”*

Further, as was clearly stated by the Deputy Leader:



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*The Leader of the Opposition in good faith wrote to the Integrity Commissioner seeking advice when this issue was mentioned in the media. The Integrity Commissioner wrote back and said—*

*Thank you for your letter of 27 May 2024 seeking my advice about the Government's proposal for retrospective legislation requiring registered lobbyists to identify and register lobbying contacts with Shadow Ministers and Assistant Shadow Ministers ... dating back to November 2020.*

*She went on—*

*In my view, the proposal to extend the obligation to record contact between registered lobbyists and Shadow Ministers, is a sound one as it strengthens the regulation of lobbying activity in Queensland...*

*The Leader of the Opposition said we would do that at the time. There is legislation now being introduced—prospective legislation—and which we have indicated support for..*

*She then said—*

*The proposal to make the requirement retrospective is more problematic.*

*The Integrity Commissioner then went on with two issues, the first being administrative burden to meet the retrospective requirements, which is at odds with what the Leader of the House says. I will take the advice of the Integrity Commissioner over the advice of the Leader of the House any day. She then said—*

*Even if such searches were conducted it is unlikely this would result in a reliable and complete record of contacts.*

*She explained why. She said—*

*In other words, the Premier's stated aim of ensuring "that the public is aware of all engagements between registered lobbyists and the LNP Opposition" probably cannot be achieved.*

The Opposition was clearly minded to support prospective legislation dealing with lobbyists and meetings with shadow ministers and shadow assistant ministers.

We also sought the Integrity Commissioner's advice so far as it relates to expanding the prospective legislative amendments to cover portfolio committee chairs.



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We note that the Integrity Commissioner responded that she considered our proposal to extend the contact reporting requirements to Chairs of Parliamentary Committees given the importance of Committee work had merit.

The Deputy Leader of the Opposition ultimately moved amendments to the motion before Parliament.

Unfortunately, and to our surprise, the Labor Party voted against extending this transparency measure to cover portfolio committee chairs.

For ease of reference, I have **enclosed** the following copies of correspondence:

1. Letter from the Leader of the Opposition to the Integrity Commissioner dated 27 May 2024;
2. Response from the Integrity Commissioner dated 19 June 2024;
3. Letter from Fiona Simpson MP to the Integrity Commissioner dated 30 August 2024; and
4. Response from the Integrity Commissioner dated 2 September 2024.

In response to the order of the Legislative Assembly dated 21 August 2024 for a shadow minister or shadow assistant ministers of the 57<sup>th</sup> Parliament to declare a list of any meetings they attended in their shadow portfolio capacity which they are aware of, at which a registered lobbyist was in attendance I can advise as follows:

In the letter from the Fiona Simpson MP to the Integrity Commissioner sent on 30 August 2024, the difficulties of complying with Labor's Order were outlined as follows:

*"While the Opposition believes this is an entirely political move to divert Opposition resources in the shadows of an election, we are attempting to comply with the order. In doing so, we have encountered exactly the hurdles you have previously identified. Apart from the difficulty of searching the Parliamentary Systems, the major issue is the sheer number of records we have to search. We have estimated it will take 1 staff member from each of the Electorate Offices an average of 48 days to go through an estimated 200 000 pages at 3 min per page. We have calculated this figure using figures supplied on behalf of Steven Miles MP when his Department refused a Right to Information request relating to the proposal for crisis accommodation at Griffith University."*

In this same letter, we requested the Integrity Commissioner write to all Lobbyist Entities requesting assistance to comply with the Order. Unfortunately, Privacy Legislation prevented the Integrity Commissioner from assisting in this way.



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Noting that shadow ministers and assistant shadow ministers are prohibited from being administratively supported by the Opposition Office and rely on their electorate staff to oversee their diary, we have consulted with the electorate offices to understand the efforts taken to meet the requirements of the Order.

After this consultation, the enormous amount of time it would take to manually search around 200 000 records became apparent. It also became apparent it would be impossible to achieve this by 6 September 2024.

In order to comply with the Order and reveal the meetings with lobbyists that we “are aware of” as of 6 September 2024 we followed the following steps:

1. Each shadow minister and shadow assistant minister conducted a word search of ‘lobbyist’ in their diary covering the period of the 57<sup>th</sup> Parliament.
2. The Lobbyist Register Disclosure Log for the period of the 57<sup>th</sup> Parliament was downloaded.
3. All entries for the Leader, Deputy Leader, Shadow Ministers and Assistant Ministers were identified and the remaining entries excluded.
4. All emails and telephone entries were excluded.
5. All entries that were able to be confirmed as not being meeting (eg emails) were excluded.
6. Entries involving the Leader of the Opposition are excluded as his diary is published under a different scheme.
7. Entries for the Deputy Leader and Shadow Ministers covering the period from March 2024 onwards were excluded as these Diaries are published under a different scheme.

As a result of the above process, the Opposition can supply three sources:

1. Electorate Office Disclosures (Attached)
2. Extract of Lobbyist Register Disclosure Log (Attached)
3. Published Diaries of the Leader of the Opposition, the Deputy Leader of the Opposition and Shadow Ministers located at:

I note that the obligation imposed on members who fall within the remit of the Order is greater than the obligation on Assistant Ministers.

I emphasise that the above-mentioned sources constitute our best endeavours in the time available based on the records available to our members as of today’s date and that the list may be incomplete or have gaps because of the retrospective nature of





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the Order. For example, the information collected was compliant at the time of the meeting but is now insufficient to meet the retrospective order.

I request the entirety of this letter and attachments be tabled pursuant to the Order of the House.

Dear Commissioner, *Linda.*

The Premier has written requesting my support for retrospective legislation to force lobbyists to declare all meetings with Shadow Ministers going back to November 2020. Legislation in this area is complicated – illustrated by the fact the Government has made numerous changes and has only now identified this loophole. The level of complication is only exacerbated by retrospective legislation.

To this end, I would like your advice on this request and have listed some questions below to which I would greatly appreciate your advice so as to assist me in providing a fulsome answer to the Premier's request.

1. Under our unicameral system, Shadow Ministers have little to no decision-making power. In contrast, Committee Chairs have the power to decide which legislation is recommended to pass the house along with strong powers to decide the direction of Estimates Hearings. If legislation is introduced to compel lobbyists to declare meetings with Shadow Ministers, should the legislation also compel the lobbyist to declare meetings with Committee Chairs?
2. According to *Legislative Standards Act 1992*, section 4(3)(g), Legislation should not adversely affect rights and liberties, or impose obligations, retrospectively. The Office of the Queensland Parliamentary Counsel (OQPC) advises in the OQPC Notebook "Strong argument is required to justify an adverse affect on rights and liberties, or imposition of obligations, retrospectively." In your opinion, has the Government put forward a sufficiently strong argument to justify the retrospective legislation it proposes?
3. If you deem there is a sufficiently strong argument the aforementioned retrospective legislation is justified, what timeframe do you deem reasonable for its implementation?

I appreciate the above questions are not simple ones and will require a consultation process. I look forward to your advice on this important issue. In the meantime I will advise the Premier I have sort your guidance in an effort to provide him with a fulsome response to his letter which I have attached.

Dear Mr Crisafulli,

Thank you for your letter of 27 May 2024 seeking my advice about the Government's proposal for retrospective legislation requiring registered lobbyists to identify and register lobbying contacts with Shadow Ministers and Assistant Shadow Ministers (**Shadow Ministers**<sup>1</sup>) dating back to November 2020.

As you know, the *Integrity Act 2009* (Integrity Act), insofar as it concerns members of the Opposition, only requires registered lobbyists to record in the Lobbying Register each contact they had with the Leader of the Opposition, the Deputy Leader of the Opposition, or a staff member of the Office of the Leader of the Opposition.

In my view, the proposal to extend the obligation to record contact between registered lobbyists and Shadow Ministers, is a sound one as it strengthens the regulation of lobbying activity in Queensland. As the Crime and Corruption Commission (CCC) observed:

*Information collected by the CCC demonstrates that influence can be obtained in a variety of ways, including by people "grooming" or developing relationships with government or Opposition representatives to position themselves to exert influence over government decisions.<sup>2</sup>*

Indeed the CCC went on to recommend that the definition of "government representative" and "Opposition representative" explicitly include all Members of Parliament and electorate employees.<sup>3</sup>

It follows that I also consider there is merit in your proposal to extend the contact reporting requirements to Chairs of Parliamentary Committees given the importance of Committee work. In this regard I also note the Queensland Parliament website which states:

*The chairperson of each portfolio committee plays an important role. When governments have a majority in the Legislative Assembly but not in the portfolio committees, as is the case at present, the chairperson has a casting vote. This means they are able to determine the outcome if an equal number of members vote for and against a proposed decision.<sup>4</sup>*

The proposal to make the requirement retrospective is more problematic.

In respect of retrospectively, the Queensland Fundamental Legislative Principles Handbook states, by way of summary:

*Retrospective legislation may interfere with the rights and liberties of an individual under section 4(3)(g) of the Legislative Standards Act 1992 and if it has an adverse affect on rights and liberties, or imposes obligations, then a **strong argument is required to justify that impact.**<sup>5</sup> However, retrospective legislation may be justified if it beneficial, curative or validating in nature.<sup>6</sup>*

In my view there are two key issues to consider before making the requirement retrospective to November 2020:

#### 1. Administrative burden to meet retrospective requirements

There is presently no legislative requirement for a registered lobbyist to create or maintain a record of communications they have with any person who is not a government or opposition representative under the current definition. If records do exist, they are unlikely to be centralised (e.g. records will consist of phone records, hard or electronic diaries, invoicing systems, or notebooks). Furthermore, any past recorded contact may or may not be lobbying activity as defined under the *Integrity Act*.

Retrospectivity would create a significant administrative burden on registered lobbyists by necessitating a review of all business records across multiple media (e.g. billing, phone records, email accounts etc) to identify each instance of contact with current and past Shadow Ministers, and then an assessment of each contact to determine if it is a lobbying contact.

Even if such searches were conducted it is unlikely that this would result in a reliable and complete record of contacts.

In other words, the Premier's stated aim of ensuring "that the public is aware of all engagements between registered lobbyists and the LNP Opposition" probably cannot be achieved.

2. Challenges to compliance and consequences for non-compliance

For registered lobbyists, a failure to record lobbying activities could give rise to a ground for their registration to be cancelled with a consequential loss of income. This is a significant and disproportionate consequence for failing to comply with obligations retrospectively imposed on them.

In my view, the imposition of a significant administrative burden on registered lobbyists, together with the potential for significant penalties for non-compliance, is inconsistent with the fundamental legislative principle concerning retrospectivity and would need to be justified on strong public interests grounds. On balance, I do not consider that threshold has been reached.

Thank you for seeking my views on this important issue.

Dear Ms Simpson,

Thank you for your letter dated 30 August 2024 which refers to the order of the Legislative Assembly moved on 21 August 2024, relating to Opposition representatives and which applies retrospectively requiring a list of interactions with registered lobbyists.

You asked if I could assist Opposition representatives by writing to all lobbyists and requesting any records of lobbyist meetings with Shadow Ministers and Assistant Shadow Ministers since November 2020.

In order to assist I must consider whether I can do so lawfully having regard to the *Information Privacy Act 2009* (the **IP Act**).

The IP Act provides that I can only use personal information (which includes a person's email) for a purpose directly related to the purpose for which it was collected. Accordingly, I must have regard what our collection statement provides for when an entity or the employees within an entity, apply for registration as a lobbyist.

The collection statement which is provided to registered lobbyists when they apply for registration is contained in Annexure A. It states that the personal information collected for the purpose of becoming a registered lobbyist will only be used in assessing and deciding applications and for the regulation of lobbying under Chapter 4 of the *Integrity Act 2009*.

Consequently, in the circumstances, I am not able to assist in the way you have requested as the use does not relate to one of the stated purposes.

However, what I can provide is list of registered lobbyists (Annexure 2) which is publicly available on my [office's website](#). This information is available to be downloaded electronically from the website. It should be noted that this list only includes lobbyists

who are currently registered lobbyists and does not capture anyone that has deregistered since November 2020.

Dear Commissioner

I refer to the order of the Legislative Assembly which the Government moved on 21 August 2024 (attached). In previous correspondence with the Opposition relating to retrospectively requiring the production of lobbyist interactions you identified a number of difficulties in relation to producing an accurate record.

While the Opposition believes this is an entirely political move to divert Opposition resources in the shadows of an election, we are attempting to comply with the order. In doing so, we have encountered exactly the hurdles you have previously identified. Apart from the difficulty of searching the Parliamentary Systems, the major issue is the sheer number of records we have to search. We have estimated it will take one staff member from each of the Electorate Offices an average of 48 days to go through an estimated 200,000 pages at three minutes per page. We have calculated this figure using figures supplied on behalf of Steven Miles MP when his Department refused a Right to Information request relating to the proposal for crisis accommodation at Griffith University.

It is on this basis we believe it is an unachievable task to provide this information by 6 September 2024 without your assistance. I am hoping you can assist the Opposition by writing to all Lobbyists and requesting any records of Lobbyist Meetings with Shadow and Assistant Shadow Ministers since November 2020.

I look forward to any assistance or advice you can provide in order to comply with this order.
